JUDGMENT ENTRY UPON JURY
VERDICT FINDING DEFENDANT
NOT GUILTY

DEFENDANT.

This matter came on before the Court on the 21ST and 22ND days of March, 2011, for a trial by jury, the defendant having heretofore been indicted by the Clermont County Grand Jury for Felonious Assault in violation of Section 2903.11(A) (1), a felony of the second degree. The defendant personally appeared and was represented by counsel, William J. Rapp.

A jury of twelve persons was duly empaneled, and thereafter evidence was presented on behalf of the State of Ohio. Closing arguments were made, and the court then charged the jury on the appropriate law to be applied. The jury, after due consideration, returned a verdict finding the defendant not guilty of Felonious Assault.

Based upon said verdict, the court hereby enters judgment finding defendant not guilty. Defendant is hereby discharged and bond, if any, may be released.
